Answers to Common Questions

- ▷ The horizon is ~2 miles away
- ▷ You are on the light side of the moon
- ▷ There is no cocaine in the first-aid kit
- ▷ FM radios are line-of-sight

NASAnswers / Debrief

1. Oxygen
2. Water
3. Stellar map
4. Food concentrate
5. FM receiver-transmitter
6. Nylon rope (useful for scaling cliffs / tying injured together)
7. First-aid kit
8. Parachute silk (protection from the sun)
9. Life raft (CO₂ bottle can be used for propulsion)
10. Signal flares
11. Pistols (possible self-propulsion)
12. Milk (bulky, made redundant by food concentrate)
13. Heating unit (useless on light side)
14. Compass (moon's magnetic field isn't polarized)
15. Matches (no oxygen to sustain flame)
